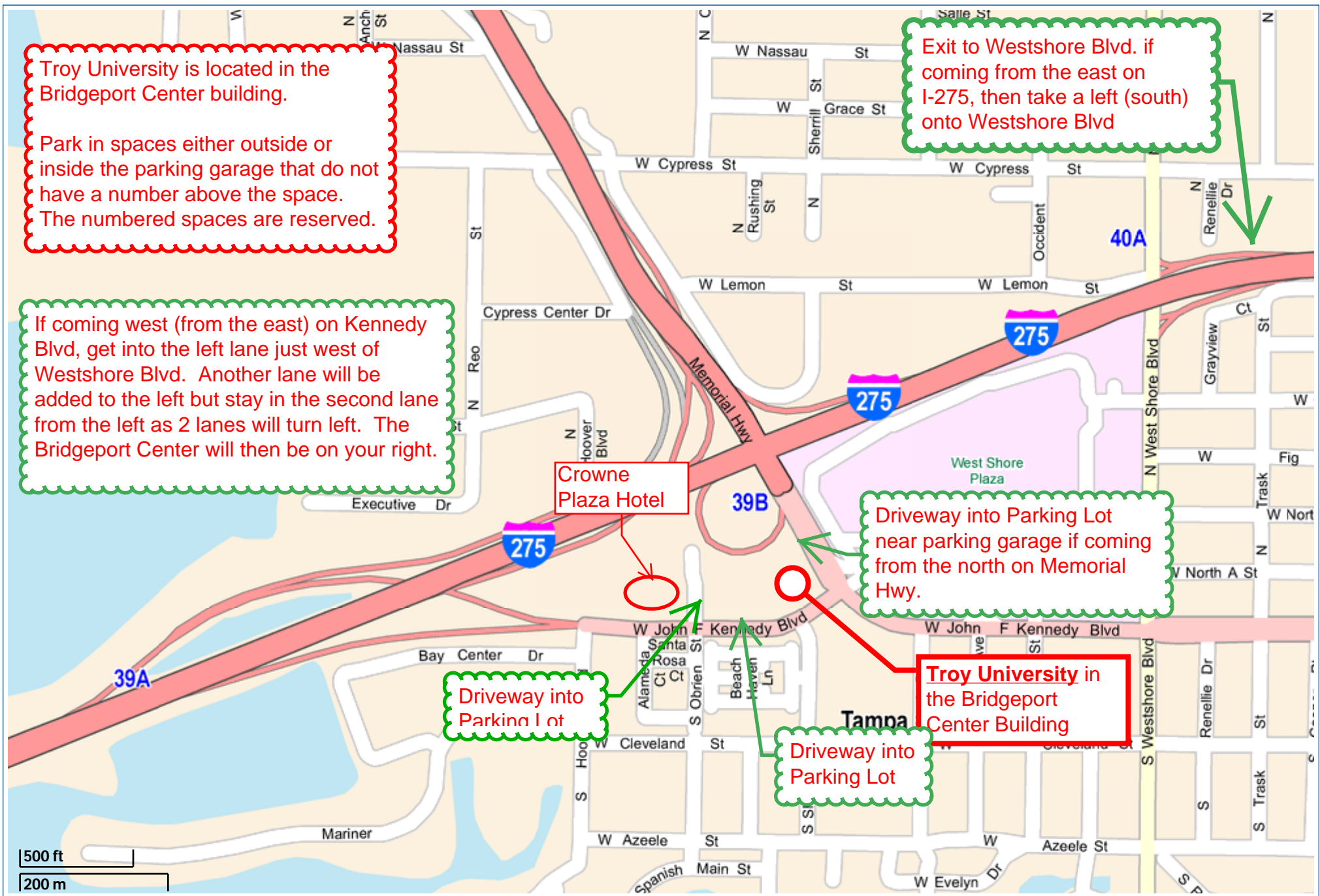

Adolescent Moral Development: This interactive program addresses the gender differences associated with how we define, measure, and enhance moral reasoning. We review the research findings derived from the author and discuss how the father's presence in a juvenile's life constitutes a greater moderating factor than generally believed. Suggestions for future research and clinical implications are then discussed.
